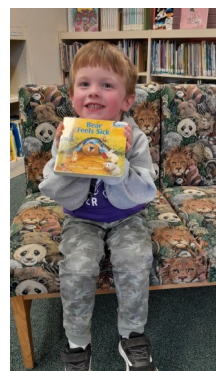

1,000 BOOKS BEFORE KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM



We implemented this program in January of 2023. Almost a year later, we have 30 children registered. 13 have reached 100 books read, 6 have reached 200 books read, 5 have reached 300 & 400 books read and 3 have reached 500 & 600 books read. What an accomplishment for these children and those who are reading to them! With each milestone, children receive a prize including a re-usable tote bag, books for home libraries, activity packs, and more! Active participants are featured on our "Wall of Readers" in the picture book room—check it out next time you visit! The reading logs do not require book titles—stickers or coloring circles makes tracking easier on parents & caregivers. If you are interested in registering your baby, toddler, or preschooler stop by the circulation desk for your welcome packet.
