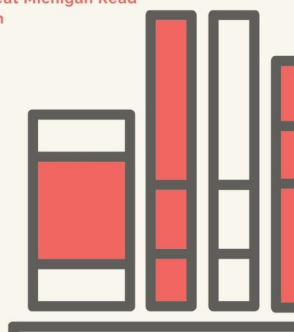

Grandma Cindy was there to greet the newborn and returned to Michigan in time to hold the 5:00 meeting! We approved spending requests from Library Director Tiffany Haight for hoopla, Canva Pro renewal, DVD's, newsletters costs, media materials, and *Take Your Child to the Library* activities and materials. The members also approved renewal of Friends of Michigan Libraries (FOML) dues, a \$1,000 donation to the Dolly Parton Imagination Library, and 10% of our fundraising profits for 2023 to Community Foundation for Oceana County. The success of our most recent fundraiser Celebration of the Trees, was applauded with more than \$4,500 raised after expenses.
