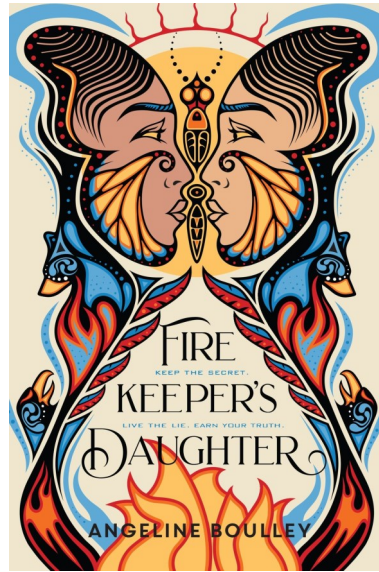

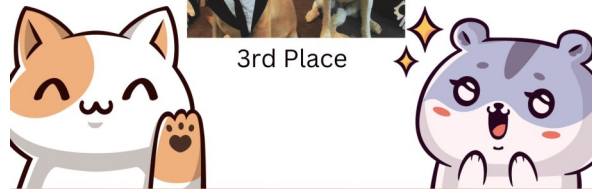

September 2023: prize baskets for Library Card Sign Up Month and staff training opportunity in Cadillac

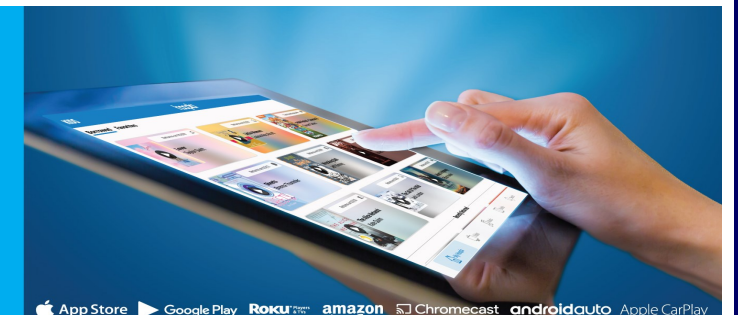
